## National Night Out Against Crime

The City of Altoona will be sponsoring a "National Night Out Against Crime" event on Tuesday, August 1st from 6:00pm to 9:00pm in Heritage Plaza in Downtown Altoona.

National Night Out is an annual event held nationwide to promote and enhance police-community partnerships and neighborhood relationships to make neighborhoods safer, more caring places to live.

During Altoona's "National Night Out Against Crime," various agencies will be hosting displays including Altoona Police Department, Altoona Fire Department, AMED, Pennsylvania Office of the Attorney General, Operation Our Town, Because We Care Foundation, UPMC Altoona, and more.
