

**AMENDED AND RESTATED FEE RESOLUTION NUMBER 0106-15**

**WHEREAS**, on September 23, 2009, the City Council of the City of Altoona adopted Resolution 0121-09 (“Fee Resolution”) which established fees be paid for various matters such as applications, permits and licenses; and,

**WHEREAS**, on April 28, 2010, City Council amended and restated said Fee Resolution by Resolution Number 0072-10 to adjust certain fees related to rental registration and PLCB hearings; and

**WHEREAS**, on September 22, 2010, by Resolution 0156-10 the City Council amended and restated the Fee Resolution to adjust certain fees to cover the cost of an inspection agent; and

**WHEREAS**, on October 13, 2010, by Resolution 0160-10 the City Council amended and restated the Fee Resolution to adjust certain fees to cover increased costs related to fire protection, planning and parking; and

**WHEREAS**, on September 14, 2011, by Resolution 0119-11, the City Council amended and restated the Fee Resolution to make certain corrections to the Rental Registration and Health Inspection Fees; and

**WHEREAS**, on April 11, 2012, by Resolution 0053-12, the City Council amended and restated the said Fee Resolution to add a fee of \$10.00 for late payment of the annual Rental Registration License per unit and to restate the said Fee Resolution as amended; and

**WHEREAS**, on September 12, 2012, by Resolution 0106-12, City Council amended and restated the said Fee Resolution to add fees for collection of delinquent flat rate occupation, local services and per capita taxes; fees for vacation of streets and alleys; and correct the fee for non-criminal finger printing; and

**WHEREAS**, on October 24, 2012, by Resolution 0128-12, City Council amended and restated the said Fee Resolution include fees for street openings and adjust the fees for stormwater management review and for copies of City maps; and

**WHEREAS**, on January 23, 2013, by Resolution 0005-13, City Council amended and restated the said Fee Resolution to include Business and mercantile License fees; adjust the fees charged for building plan review by third party inspectors and adjust for zoning map changes and zoning curative amendments; and

**WHEREAS**, on February 13, 2013, by Resolution 0022-13, City Council amended the said Fee Resolution to include monthly parking rates; and

**WHEREAS**, on June 12, 2013, by Resolution 0078-13, City Council adopted a codification of all the City’s ordinances which now requires that certain fees be adopted by resolution of Council and Council desires to amend the said Fee Resolution to include such fees as required by the said codification and amend certain fire safety related fees including alarm fees and cost recovery fees; and

**WHEREAS**, on December 11, 2013 City Council amended the said Fee Resolution to include monthly parking rates for 2014; and

**WHEREAS**, on December 10, 2014 City Council amended the said Fee Resolution to include monthly parking rates for 2015; and

**WHEREAS**, on December 9, 2015 City Council amended the said Fee Resolution to include monthly parking rates for 2016, Blueprints, City Maps, Code Appeals Application Fees, Engineering Plan Review Fees, Floodplain Elevation Permit Fees, Storm water Management Review Fees, Land Development Fees, Subdivision Fees, Zoning Fees, Sewer Cap Inspection Permit Fees and Right to Know/Open Records Fees; and

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT** and it is hereby resolved by the City Council of the City that the said Fee Resolution is hereby amended, and any resolution in conflict is hereby rescinded, with all language to be added being indicated by underlining and all language to be deleted indicated by ~~strike through~~ and as amended the same is to be restated in its entirety as follows:
