INTRODUCTION

Summit Legal Aid (SLA) contracted with the City of Altoona to provide fair housing services from July 1, 2024 through June 30, 2025. SLA agreed to provide education and outreach within the City, to distribute fair housing information, to host a fair housing month event, and to provide technical assistance on fair housing matters. SLA maintained a social media presence in the City as an additional way to reach residents and educate on fair housing rights and remedies.

SLA's intake coordinator
maintained the City of Altoona Fair
Housing Hotline and assisted
callers who had fair housing issues
get connected with a SLA attorney.
For those calling about issues
unrelated to fair housing, SLA gave
appropriate referrals to other
community agencies.



AT A GLANCE

Fair Housing Services

\$30,000 expended

FY 2023 Budget: SLA focused project spending on the bulk of this budget on educating tenants and service providers. The number of referrals from Altoona increased slightly; however, SLA received a 50% reduction in Altoona hotline calls over last year. Many more referrals are coming directly to SLA because of its presence in the community.


Outreach + Training

November 8, 2024: SLA presented on fair housing at the annual Landlord Workshop hosted by Operation our Town and the Altoona Housing Authority.

The presentation focused on common fair housing violations, including:

- Discriminatory Advertising & Statements
- Making Housing Unavailable
- Terms & Conditions
- False Denial of Availability
- Steering
- Coercion, Intimidation, Threats, and Interference
- Harassment-general
- Harassment- sexual harassment
- Denial of Reasonable Modifications
- Denial of Reasonable Accommodations

June 27, 2025: SLA presented on fair housing for the Center for Community Action. The training covered who is protected under the Fair Housing Act, what is prohibited under the Act, what remedies exist, and disability-specific topics, including reasonable accommodations and reasonable modifications.

FAIR HOUSING MONTH

This year, SLA held a joint event with the Pennsylvania Human Relations Commission. Altoona stakeholders were invited to a focus group which allowed SLA to learn, and the participants to share, what fair housing issues and needs exist in the city.

REFERRALS

Total Calls

- 52 calls were received through the Altoona hotline and direct calls to Summit
- (-20 from 2023-2024)

Fair Housing

- 14 calls alleged housing discrimination
- Allegations of sex, disability, race, and familial status discrimination
- opened 3 cases
- (+3 from 2023-2024)

Landlord Tenant

- 28 calls
- callers alleged evictions, VAWA issues, criminal history as a barrier, habitability issues, asked lease questions,
- (-16 from 2022-2023)

Needed Housing

- 2 other housing calls were received
- (-2 from2023-2023)

Other Legal Issues

- 3 calls
- (-1 from 2023-2024)

Technical Assistance

- 1 request for TA was received
- (no change from 2023-2024)

Four callers left a message on the fair housing line but could not be reached for follow-up. This was the same as 2022-23.

These numbers include both Altoona hotline call and calls received directly by SLA.
