ATTACHMENT A

City of Altoona - American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) 2023 Business District Revitalization Grant Program Guidelines

Small businesses are the heartbeat of any business district and provide a foundation for a thriving community. The COVID-19 pandemic posed unique and far-reaching challenges that have caused the type of hardship for these businesses not seen in generations. The City of Altoona has established the Business District Revitalization Grant Program using ARPA funds to assist businesses with 50 or fewer employees within the City's municipal boundaries with up to \$25,000 for:

- Physical improvements to existing commercial buildings within the City;
- Professional design services related to these physical improvements; and/or
- The purchase of capital equipment valued at \$1,000 or more.

Projects should be ready to go, with a clear timeline, and must be contracted by December 31, 2023 and completed by September 30, 2024.

Priority will be given to new businesses, as well as new grantees. Unsuccessful applicants from the prior round of funding must reapply. Applicants are required to sign a consent to release information and obtain Act 34 Clearance at https://epatch.pa.gov

The project budget must be based on quotes, bids or contracts and describe any other secured funding needed to make the project possible. Payment will require submission of invoices and inspection and approval by City staff. Grantees must provide the City with copies of all required City permits, licensures and fee payment receipts prior to payment.

Physical Improvements/Equipment Grants:

Eligible Businesses: Any new or existing business with 50 employees or less that is located

within the geographical limits of the City of Altoona. New recipients will be given

priority.

Eligible Costs: 1. Renovations to existing buildings located within the City of Altoona including

professional design services related to these renovations

2. Purchase of capital equipment (excludes mobile units)

Amounts: \$25,000 grant limit

Match Requirement: None

Cost Documentation: Contracts, quotes, bids, and/or receipts supporting the requested amount

must be submitted with the application.

Requirements: All projects will be within the municipal boundaries of the City of Altoona.

Completion of the Consent to Release Information form is required for any individual whose ownership meets or exceeds 20% of the applicant business.

All applicant signatories must submit an Act 34 Clearance available at:

https://epatch.pa.gov

Payment: No payment will be made to applicants before purchase or procurement of

services. Payment will be issued through third-party check(s) or reimbursement with acceptable receipts upon documented completion of the project, including proof of business licenses, permits, and codes sign-off as applicable. Projects must be under contract by December 31, 2023 and completed by September 30,

2024.

Grant Objectives: Applicants must evidence one or more of the following outcomes:

- Create a positive impact on real estate/wage tax base within the City;
- Create new employment opportunities within the City;
- Redevelop/Rehab of existing properties within the City, with emphasis on blight

remediation or prevention; and/or

- (Re)Develop an existing vacant site within the City.

Expenditures may be verified through an auditing process.

STANDARD PROVISIONS
